The Surveyors should be informed it is noted from the First Entry Report which has been forwarded that the scantlings indicated thereon coincide ~~in every particular~~ <sup>generally</sup> with the particulars shown on the plan of midship ~~section~~ <sup>principal</sup> which has been forwarded, and it is concluded that the scantlings shown in the report have been taken from the plan and have not been verified, by drilling or otherwise, from the ship, but they should state if this is so, and in any future similar cases this point should be made clear so that there may be no dubiety as to the arrangements required to be made for the completion of the Survey. <sup>now on board</sup>

With regard to the equipment, and the eventual assignment of the figure 1, no particulars as to the weight, ~~size~~, test or origin have been furnished in the report, and the Surveyors should state whether <sup>as</sup> certificates were not available for the verification of the equipment, ~~whether~~ no markings were discernible or other evidence <sup>available</sup> in respect thereto.

It is concluded that particulars of the stream wire, towline, hawsers and warps were not ascertained in the course of the Survey at New York. x

It is further concluded the fee of \$50 indicated on the report 8 was charged in respect to the General Examination and the issue of a report 10 to the British Authority and does not cover any part of the Classification Survey.
