The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

("The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/6/92.)

The 3rd S.S.No.2 became due 1,38 and a proposal to carry out same in May 1939 without any period of grace, has been agreed to.

The Genoa Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated, rudder pintles and gudgeons dealt with, renewals effected to upper deck plating in midship deck house, repairs to mainmast where corroded under an electric cable tube and minor repairs carried out.

The Owners request the present examination of the midship deck house be taken account of when the Special Survey is held.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 1,38.
