Dear Sir,

We are forwarding herewith enclosed copy, with free translation, of a letter dated 23rd instant received from the Owners of the tanker "ALABAMA", from which it will be seen that they submit, for the favourable consideration of the Committee, their proposal that the next Special Survey 3rd N°2 for this vessel become due in May 1939, namely four years after the date of the completion of last Special Survey carried out at this port, as per Genoa Report N°13915 dated 13/5/35, instead of eight years after the date of the last S.S. 2nd N°3, i.e. 1.38. 1.30

From the documents in this Office we have been able to ascertain that, the major part of the last hull Special Survey, was held from January until early in May 1935, namely internal examination and testing of oil fuel and cargo tanks and examination of vessel in dry dock, while the major part of the machinery was examined in December 1934, January & April 1935.

Further in September 1935 the vessel was again examined at Genoa for a condition survey in dry dock and testing of cargo tanks N°2 to 7 inclusive, to the light waterline, which had to be done to complete the 3rd Special Survey N°1 (as per Genoa Report N°14115 dated 24/9/35).

Again the vessel was examined at La Spezia and Genoa for equipment, boiler and a condition surveys in December 1936 and

and January 1937 (as per Genoa Reports Nos.14689 & 14693), respectively.

The Direction of the Registro Italiano at Genoa have confirmed to us, as stated in the Owners' letter, that in December 1935 Mr. G. Pietrapiana (also Lloyd's Register Non-Exclusive Surveyor) had carried out at La Spezia ordinary hull and machinery surveys, and, owing to the satisfactory result of them, they had decided to give to this vessel the record of Special Survey 3rd N°2 - 12,35 and a classification certificate was issued to this effect, so that, for that Institution, the next Special Survey is due 12.39, and it will be called 3rd N°3.

Although not mentioned in their letter, the Owners have verbally informed us that they will very much appreciate if it will be possible also for our Society to follow the decision taken by the Registro Italiano and combine then the dates of surveys. If desired the Owners are prepared to supply copies of the reports of the survey held at La Spezia by Mr. G. Pietrapiana in December, 1935.

This case is similar in some respect to that of the "AMERICANO" (the sister vessel of the "ALABAMA"), please see your letter "S" of the 6th April, 1934.
