Dear Sir:

I am in receipt of your letter of the 17th inst. enclosing a copy of a letter received by you from the Secretary, London.

I regret that a copy of my Certificate handed to Mr. White at this office was not forwarded to you for transmission to London. My only reason for not doing so was that it was substantially the same as a Certificate signed by Mr. Richardson and others, a copy of which I was informed was already in your possession. The only difference between my Certificate and the one signed by Mr. Richardson, and others, was in the date of survey and Port.

The actual Certificate being exactly the same it did not occur to me at the moment that it was necessary to forward a Certificate to you.
