WHITE FOR TRANSMISSION ITALIAN HULL UNDERWRITERS WHO REQUESTED WHITE OBTAIN STATEMENT FROM SURVEYORS TO SUBSTANTIATE HIS REPORT STOP NEW YORK DOCUMENT SIGNED BY RICHARDSON IN CONJUNCTION WITH UNDERWRITERS SURVEYOR AND MR. SILLIMAN OF STANDARD SHIPPING WHO WAS UNDERSTOOD TO BE REPRESENTING OWNERS INTERESTS STOP SLIGHT WAVING IN DECK PLATING NOTED BY SURVEYORS BUT MASTER STATED SAME EXISTED PRIOR TO HEAVY WEATHER DAMAGE FOR WHICH SURVEY WAS CALLED AND PLATING NOT LISTED BY MASTER IN DAMAGE ITEMS CLAIMED STOP COPIES OF CERTIFICATES NOT RECEIVED THIS OFFICE UNTIL YOUR RADIOGRAM RAISED QUESTION".
