

"ALABAMA" an arrangement whereby the exhaust gases after leaving the smoke tubes are passed around a portion of the exterior of the shell before entering the uptakes we have to acquaint you we have been in communication with the aforementioned firm, and beg to forward under separate cover, ¹¹ plans - in triplicate - showing details of Boilers Insulation, Clearance between Bulkheads and Boilers and Plans showing particulars of Stund Pipes for the Boiler mountings.
