Précis of particulars of Casualty Attacked by German aircraft at La Pallice on the 20th June, 1940. Beached, flooded throughout and decks destroyed.

Upon enquiry of Lloyds it has been ascertained that the Underwriters have settled this case as a total loss, and her tonnage has been included in the Admiralty total for the week ended 23rd June, last.

29th March, 1943.

According to recent proceedings in the Hamburg Prize Court, this vessel has been confiscated by the Germans.

In the circumstances IT IS SUBMITTED that all her particulars be reinstated in the Society's Register Book, with the notation of SURVEYS DELAYED.

HAMBURG PRIZE COURT

Allied Vessels Condemned

The Hamburg Prize Court has ordered the confiscation of four Allied ships which were seized after the collapse of France in Continental ports, according to the German Radio, quoted by Renter. They are the 431-ton British barge *Shellfuel* (seized on the River Scheldt), the 835-ton British merchant ship *Bawtry* (sunk by a bomb in Dunkirk Harbour and later raised), a British motor sailing yacht captured by the Germans near St. Malo, and the Greek steamer *Adamantios*, bombed off La Pallice while on the way to England.
