In reply to your enquiry contained in the
Classing letter dated 14th instant referring to the Newcastle
Report No.82336 on the s.s."BEAVERDALE", I beg to inform you
(1) that the length of the double bottom and deep water ballast
tanks are as follows:-

No.1 D.B.(ford.) = 53.5' : No.2 = 77.25' : No.3 = 72' :
No.4 = 51' : No.5 = 27' : No.6 = 69' & No.7 = 69'
Deep tank = 39' .

(2) The diameter of the rivets through the frame and shell
plating amidships is 1".
