George Clark, Ltd., survey the machinery of the new Steamer "BARBARA MARIE", of Newcastle, 4223 tons gross, while lying afloat tipped in the South Dock, Sunderland, on the 24th April 1928, for the purpose of ascertaining the damage stated to have been caused through the cast iron propeller striking the Quay Wall, South Dock, Sunderland, on the 18th April 1928.

FOUND.

About three feet broken from one blade of the cast iron propeller.

RECOMMENDED.

The tail end shaft to be drawn inboard, examined, and a new cast iron propeller fitted.

These recommendations were made and effected in order to place the machinery, as far as practicable, in the same condition as before the alleged casualty occurred.
