With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the motorship "BENJAMIN FRANKLIN", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a report received from the Society's Surveyors at Vancouver, from which it appears that the Special Survey No. 3 was completed at that port in December last, so far as the hull of the vessel was concerned.

In the circumstances they have assigned a notation of "S.S. No. 3-3,40" on the understanding that the present cycle of the Continuous Survey of the oil engines will be completed whenever practicable without delaying the ship.

I think it well to add that the Screwshaft Survey was also carried out at Vancouver.
