The Barrow Surveyors report the vessel examined afloat and alterations effected to accommodation spaces^{etc} to the Surveyors' satisfaction. (as per approved plan attached)

Opportunity was taken to examine side framing and bilges in Nos.1 & 2 holds in way of insulation now part removed for repairs.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
