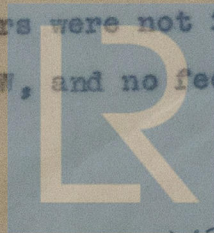
Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 11th instant enclosing one from Messrs. The Ardrossan Dockyard, Ltd., regarding the fees charged for the survey of the motorship "PACIFIC COAST" (Glasgow Report No. 55801).

With regard to the Builders' remarks, it is concluded the alleged overlapping of charges refers to the fee of £15.15.0 for the three auxiliary engines supplied by Messrs. Davey, Paxman & Co., plus £2.2.0 for air receiver and 16/6d travelling expenses in connexion therewith, payment of which was received on the 4th April, last.

These fees were charged in accordance with the established rule applying to auxiliaries constructed at works other than those at which the propelling machinery is built, and in this case there were two four-cylinder and one three-cylinder engines with one air receiver, the amount of fee charged for the survey of the same being approved in this Office in the first instance.

The electric generators were not inspected during manufacture, being under 100 KW, and no fee has been charged in connexion therewith.

The fee for the electric installation on board has been correctly calculated at £34.15.0 based on the total generator capacity of 165 KW and is, of course, in accordance with the Rule scale.
