I have to acquaint you that the new steamer "PIANTER" has left here for your port and in order to complete the survey for record of LMC 10.27 the donkey boiler safety valves require to be put in order and adjusted under steam.

When steam was raised here for that purpose the valves gave no definite lift or fall. The makers have since opened out the valves and filed the spindles but there was no opportunity of ascertaining if this treatment has been effective in remedying the defect.
