in the Register Book, are about to fit a four Cylinder
single acting four cycle Semi Diesel Motor on board of
this vessel. -

This motor made by Messrs P. Kind & Co of Turin
is said to be completed, and has not been constructed
under our survey. - The particulars are as follows: -
Diameter of each of the four cylinders 17.32", Stroke of
piston 25.19", Pressure 32 Kgs equal to 455 Lbs, Revolu-
tions 175, Horse Power 380, Span of crankshaft 24.8",
Diameter of propeller 90.55", Size of crankwebs 15.74" x
5.3", Diameter of crankshaft 9.25", Crankpins 9.45",
Screw shaft with continuous liner 9.05", Intermediate
shaft flywheel fitted 8.66", Thrust shaft 8.66", -

The sizes of shafting according to our rules

should be as follows: viz - Crankshaft 10.23", Screwshaft
 $8.2 \times .97 = 7.95$, Intermediate shaft 7.97-7.67, Thrust shaft 8.33". -

It will be noted that the crankshaft is less
in diameter than the rules require, whilst the other
