Dear Sir,

In reply to London letter of the 29th ultimo respecting Glasgow First Entry Report No. 42308 on the steamer "CLAN MACFARLANE", I beg to state that the thickness of the forecastle side plating was approved .35 and fitted .40 as stated in report; the width of the seam of "K" and "L" strakes of shell plating is as approved and as stated in report - $5\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{7}{8}$ riveting (please see approved plan of multiple riveting); the length of bridge and forecastle decks is 60 feet and 38 feet respectively.
