Nature of Survey

The class is subject to the cross bunker being tested before being used for oil fuel.

The Hamburg Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom cleaned and coated and minor repairs effected.

Alterations have been carried out in way of the tunnel recess, etc. in connection with the fitting of an exhaust steam turbine.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6,29, subject as above.
