I am in receipt of your letter of the 24th instant letter forwarding of the one from Mr. Selles, submitting for the Committee's approval the plan of the steel boilers No. 527/2/9 proposed to be made by Messrs. Bunsmair & Jackson Ltd. for Messrs. De Lapschire Dockyard Co's Nos. 490-5 Vessels. and in regard thereto, I am directed to acquaint you that, provided the steel to be used in the construction of the boilers be tested as required by the Rules, and the boilers be built and tested in accordance with the plan submitted and with the provisions of the Rules, and to the entire satisfaction of the local Engineer Surveyor, they will be approved of for the intended working pressure of 100 pounds per square inch.

The plan referred to is returned herewith, and should accompany the reports when transmitted to the Committee.
