the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs Marine & Locomotive Superheaters Ltd, of Manchester attend at their works on the 21st September 1920 and subsequently for the purpose of testing by hydraulic pressure 24 pressed steel headers and elements for same intended for Superheaters to the order of Messrs Dunsmuir & Jackson of Glasgow, for their Vessel No. 482.

The pressed steel headers were tested in accordance with the requirements of the Society's Rules.

The finished headers were tested in my presence by hydraulic pressure to 600 lbs per square inch and 10% of the elements to 2400 lbs per square inch with satisfactory results.

The headers are numbered:- CI74, CI77, CI79, CI82, CI78, CI87, 29, 23, 14, 35, 12, 15, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27, 8, 36, H1, H2I. 28, CI72, and CI81, and are stamped - LLOYDS TEST 600 LBS - with date of hydraulic test and with DMC. for identification.
