Dear Mr. Archer,

Reverting to your letter of the 1st December, 1916, intimating that a sub-division loadline, corresponding to 29.1 feet moulded draught, had been approved for this vessel as a passenger steamship, I write to say that we have to-day received the final report from our Surveyors and have assigned the freeboard accordingly.


The vessel has been completed with the addition of a forecastle, and we find the sub-division loadline requires the addition of 1/2" to the Table "A" winter line. We have accordingly assigned one line for all seasons, to correspond to the approved sub-division loadline.

I enclose for your information a copy of the computation; the usual complete copy will follow in due course. I also enclose a copy of the Table "A" computation for the dimensions reported, and draught sheet for your information.
