With reference to your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the Twin Screw Steamer No.555 proposed to be built by your goodselves, I now have pleasure in sending herewith a memorandum giving particulars of the freeboards which have been provisionally assigned, subject to the particulars and dimensions now supplied being verified on the completion of the vessel, and provided there is no tonnage opening in the deck and that there are no scuppers or other openings through the vessel's sides to affect the position of the load line disc.

I have to point out that the provisional freeboard given is for the vessel as a cargo ship only.

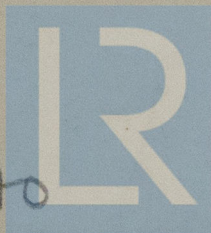
