In reply to your letter of the 19th instant I enclose memos giving the provisional freeboard and moulded depth for Messrs. Irvine's No. 555 and Messrs. Earle's No. 611. In each case we gave the provisional assignment as a cargo ship only.

Messrs. Hamilton's Nos. 303 & 306 we have not yet dealt with for provisional freeboard assignment. The moulded depths however I find from our records are 30.21' to the upper deck and 38.29' to the shelter deck.
