M. With reference to Mr. McAuslan's First Entry Report No.15499 on the new Steamer "DUQUESA", I send herewith a copy of the Owners' letter forwarded with Mr. McAuslan's Report, and have to request that he will be so good as to state if this vessel was examined in Dry Dock in the River Tyne.

It is observed that the Owners in their letter dated 15th May, state "..... we certainly think this should date from the time the vessel comes out of drydock in the River Tyne....." while the last date of Survey on the Report is given as the 22nd May. If the vessel was seen by Mr. McAuslan while in dry dock, he should state the actual date.
