With reference to Liverpool Report No. 29596 on the steamer "WAR CADET" now named "DIONYSIOS STATHATOS", I shall be glad if you will make the following enquiries of the Surveyors and let me know the result by telegram tomorrow:

Whether the 2nd deck beams and plating in way of the machinery space have been fitted in accordance with the approved plans, the collision bulkhead plating is as approved, and semi-box beams have been fitted in accordance with the approved plans. Whether a horizontal web has been fitted as required on the other bulkheads, the length of double bottom forward is as in the sister vessel, the thickness of the riveting of the sheerstrake and strake below clear of bridge is as approved.

It would be well in future if the particulars of the sheerstrake &c., clear of the bridge, were inserted in the space provided on the report form.
