I return herewith the amended plan, forwarded with your letter of the 23rd instant, of the above Boilers, and have to acquaint you that this plan of Cylindrical Multitubular Boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 120 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates and butt straps, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.


