Steam vessels sunk by enemy bombing at Dieppe.

Dear Sir,

During my visit to Dieppe I noted the following vessels which have been burned and sunk or sunk only.

STEAM TRAWLERS. Four burned out, two others sunk and one capsized.

"BRIGHTON". Found sunk and awash; no lives lost.

HOSPITAL SHIP. Found sunk and awash. This vessel it is stated by those who were present had about three hundred sick and wounded on board when she was repeatedly bombed and sunk.

GALAXIAS. Greek No. 24835 in RB, found sunk.

PERRACIS L. CAMBANIS. No. 31522 in RB, found sunk.

HUBBASTONE. No. 26276 in RB, found bombed at aft end and partially sunk aft. Enclosed please find damage report.
