My husband report on "TRENEGLOS"
reads No 456 gives a calculation based on the
(upper) deck tonnage of the sister vessel "TREGENNA"
55.

In that case the modifications were
made after the B.T. Surveyor had completed his
assessments.

In the "Treneglos" the shelter deck
taken as the tonnage deck.

We deduct from the under (shelter) deck tonnage of
"TRENEGLOS" the tonnage deck tonnage as measured
"TREGENNA" we get the figure 4126.93
which is almost the same as for "TREGENNA"

This may make the case clearer
than my report does.
