

There is no evidence from the Journals that the Hatchways, ventilators or air and sounding pipes were examined. The anchors were examined on the 9th August and the hatch covers were renewed on account of damage, and have been examined throughout.

The Riggers report on the masts, spars and rigging is enclosed herewith; the repairs recommended therein having been satisfactorily carried out.
