In compliance with the instructions contained in your letter of the 30th April re Danish vessels, we beg to forward the Load Line Certificate for this vessel to enable a British Load Line Certificate to be issued.

It is noted from your letters that you always make mention of an Annual Survey, but it would appear from questions asked from the Masters of the vessels, and from the endorsements on the Load Line Certificates themselves that no Annual Surveys are carried out for vessels having the Danish Load Line Assignment.

The Certificates are only endorsed every four years.

It is presumed, therefore, that we shall have to carry out the Annual Survey on each individual case.




