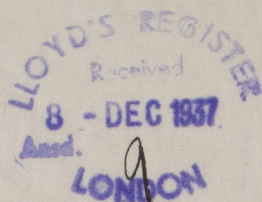

Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter S. of the 26th ultimo, respecting the boiler repairs to the s.s. "IRENE MARIA", I shall be pleased if you will kindly let me know whether you have already received from the Antwerp Surveyors samples of the soda and salts, as according to the Chief Engineer, they have taken the samples with them.

If not, only samples of the soda used are available.

The repairs to the boilers extend only to the combustion chambers and furnaces, special to the wrapper plates and I shall be glad to hear which samples of material are required and the sizes of same.

Special tests have been carried out here, particulars of which, together with photographs, will be forwarded to you on completion of my inspection.
