Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 14th instant forwarding the reports of survey held with a view to classification on the ex-German Steamer "DELIA", and with regard thereto I have to acquaint you that an inclusive of £50 should be charged for the survey and classification of this vessel, £35 being allocated to the Hull and £15 to the Machinery. The travelling expenses should be an additional charge.

It is noted that the vessel has been classed by Liverpool Committee, and in these circumstances the six-monthly condition survey reports forwarded by you would not appear to be required, and are being retained in Office. (In bag)
