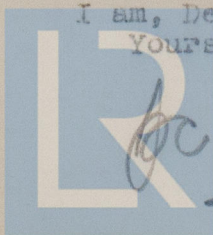

Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that in April last the Society's Surveyors at West Hartlepool measured the S.S. "LITTLETON" now named "LEONIDAS Z. CAMBANIS" for assignment of freeboard in accordance with the International Loadline Convention. It is understood that it is not the Owners' intention to complete the requirements until such time as the Convention has been ratified by the Greek Authorities. In the circumstances of this particular case, however, it is thought that as the bulk of the survey has been carried out by the Society the Owners may be prepared to pay the fee due, namely £12:15:0.

I therefore enclose a debit note for the amount due and shall be glad if you will be good enough to arrange for a call to be made upon the Owners regarding the matter.
