Dear Sir,

I am desired to send you herewith a copy of a letter which has been received here from the wireless operator of the Greek Steamer "LEONIDAS Z. CAMBANIS", having reference to the manner in which this vessel was loaded at Rosario.

You will observe that the writer desires to remain anonymous, and in connexion with his statement that the ship was loaded to a draught of 23'-9" or 10" on leaving Rosario, I may perhaps remark that the draught corresponding to the freeboard assigned by this Society is 22'-7". It would therefore appear that the ship was overloaded to the extent of 14" or 15".

The Freeboard, however, is not a condition of the vessel's classification.
