The class is subject to repairs to wasted and thin fore deck plating by 12.47, to indented bulwarks etc. (s.s.a) at the s' convenience, and to steam heating pipe in No. 1 D.B. tank examined for leakage into No. 2 D.B. tank (s.s) at the first convenient opportunity.

The last notation of Special Survey is No. 2 - 38, and Radical Special Survey (D) (1st Priority) accordingly becomes due the validity of the "Examined" notation expires, viz. 12.47 letter to Owners dated 11.11.47).

The ANTWERP Surveyors report (11.47) ship examined afloat amount of damage due to grounding, bilges and tanks sounded; but no trace of leakage found; and the rudder tried under working conditions found satisfactory.
