Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 16th instant respecting the steamer "LOS POZOS", and think it well to inform you that a communication was addressed to you, by seamount, on the 17th instant reading as follows :-

"With reference to your report No.3035 and to the entry contained in your Rtn.10 for the quarter ended June last respecting the steam tanker "LOS POZOS", I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a communication from this Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires, from which it appears that the vessel has been abandoned as a Constructive Total Loss, and in the circumstances they have decided to make a record of "Damaged by collision and fire 12.47" against the tanker's name in the Register Book and to expunge her class in accordance with the usual practice.

I shall be glad if you will inform the interested parties accordingly and point out that in the event of the vessel being repaired to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors the notation of casualty will be withdrawn immediately and reclassification by this Society."
