The owners of the above named vessel have requested that the deep tanks be tested with a view to carrying oil fuel for the ship's use therein.

In view of the advice received in classing letter dated 23d October last, having reference to New York Report No. 40295 on this case, the owners were advised that the deep tank is at present unsuitable for the carriage of oil fuel. The testing of the deep tank has therefore been deferred for the present, but I should be glad to learn by return what alterations will be necessary to permit of oil fuel being carried in these tanks.
