Dear Sir,

We thank you for your classing letter of the 6th March regarding "HARPALION", and we have pleasure in replying as follows:-

When vessel was in Leith in February 1942, two part lengths of cable were put ashore to be joined up to form one complete length and to be subsequently tested, and to be placed aboard in the future, leaving 240 fathoms remaining on board.

When the cables were ranged in Leith only 270 fathoms of cable were on board, and two part lengths were taken ashore to be dealt with as stated above.

This should have been made clear in our report and the omission is regretted; a note should be entered in the S.R. List (in italics) stating that 30 fathoms of cable are to be supplied.
