I have to add that this vessel (with the exception of an alteration to the sheers) is a sister ship to The Ailsa S.B. Co's No. 394, the freeboard of which was dealt with in your office on the 3rd instant.

The enclosed plans have not yet been dealt with and perhaps you will be so good as to return them at your earliest convenience in order that this may be done.
