Cargo vessel proposed to be built by your goodselves, and to acquaint you in reply that on the particulars furnished, and providing the usual closing appliances be fitted, an approximate summer freeboard of $7\frac{1}{2}$ inches from a statutory deck line $1\frac{1}{2}$ inches above the steel upper (second) deck at side could be approved.
