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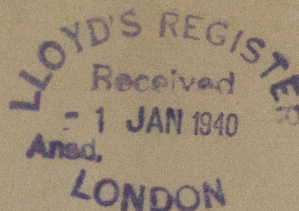

Dear Sir,

For your information we give you the following details of the British vessels which were sunk here during the Spanish movement:-

"Lucky". This vessel which was floated on the 21st. April 1939 has been chipped and painted, but not repaired, and has been renamed

"Castillo Benisano." She is moored inside the harbour.

"Greatend." Floated on the 7th. Aug. 1939. Chipped and painted but not repaired. She still retains the same name.

"Foynes." Floated on the 24th. Nov. 1939. Is being chipped and painted, but not repaired.

"Delwyn." Floated in Gandia and brought to Valencia on the 2nd. June 1939. Has been chipped and painted and renamed "Castillo Montesa." but has not been repaired.

The British vessels still sunk are:-

"Penthames" "Arlon" (Tanker) and "Sunion".
