Dear Sir,

I have to inform you that Convention Ordinary and Timber Deck Cargo Freeboards have been computed in the case of the steamer "LOKE" on the basis of the information supplied on Stockholm Report C/11 No.3592, which is returned herewith together with computations. The freeboard certificate, in triplicate, is also enclosed.

At the same time I have to inform you that the penalty required by the Swedish Authorities for the absence of ~~wood~~ at the after end of the raised quarter ~~deck~~ has been applied when computing the timber deck freeboards.

I may add that as the Convention Cargo freeboards are greater than those at present assigned, the existing cargo freeboards may be retained, and the certificates have been prepared accordingly.
