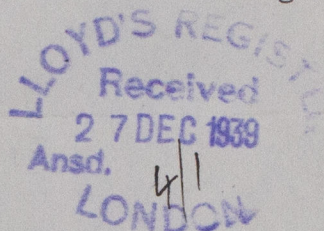

With reference to your letter of the 27th ultimo we beg to submit herewith for the consideration of the Committee further prints, in triplicate, of the Tank Pipe Arrangement, Drg. No. 10756 (2 Sheets), proposed in connection with the above vessels. It will be noted that the Auxiliary feed pump is now arranged to draw from No. 4 feed water tank; and the oil discharge from the 'Coastguard' separator is led into the oil line and not to the settling tanks.
