With reference to the plans of pumping arrangement in the machinery space approved in your letter of the 27th ultimo, we have to say that the Firm now propose to dispense with the suction from the auxiliary feed pump to the tank line and substitute ^{the} ₁ suction to feed water tanks.

Pneumercator gauges will be fitted to the settling tanks.

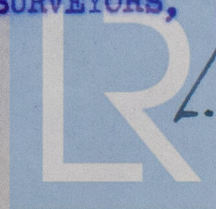
With reference to the amendment to the size of pipe No. 133, the Firm explain that it is only the branch pipes connected to the individual settling tanks which it is proposed to make 2½" dia. (which is the size of Fittings F.213). The pipe connecting F.217 and F.220 will be 3½" dia.

We have asked the Firm to indicate these connections more clearly on the final tracing, prints for which will be forwarded to you as soon as they are available.
