I return herewith three sets of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 17th instant, of Pumping Arrangement in the Machinery Space proposed for The North Eastern Marine Eng. Co's Contract Nos.2952/3, Messrs. Bartram & Sons' Yard Nos.282/3, and I have to inform you that these plans will be approved provided the arrangements be as shown and amended thereon and the remaining requirements of Sections 20 and 34 of the Rules (1939-40) be complied with so far as they are applicable.

I should point out that the auxiliary feed pump is connected to the ballast line which may contain oil or oily water, and in the circumstances this connection should be blanked off to prevent the possibility of oil entering the boilers.


