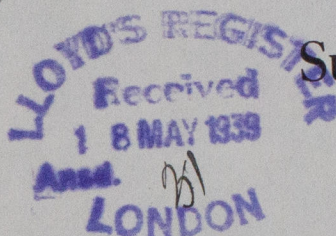

In reply to your letter of the 15th instant regarding the pumping arrangement of Messrs. Bartram & Sons' Yard Nos. 282 and 283, we have to inform you that it is not intended to carry fresh water in the Fore Peak Tank, also, the Deep Tank will be used for the carriage of cargo or water ballast only and not for the carriage of oil fuel.
