Dear Sir,

The Surveys of our S.S. "CAPITO" and S.S. "CATO" are due respectively March and April this year.

Both ships are fully employed on our regular services, the "CAPITO" to Antwerp and Rotterdam, and the "CATO" between Bristol and Dublin.

We have been trying to purchase or hire for a period tonnage to relieve them, but, up to now, have failed in our endeavours.

Under these circumstances we would request a further extension of time, say, for the "CAPITO" to June 30th, and "CATO" to the early Autumn, if events prevent our carrying out the surveys before those dates.

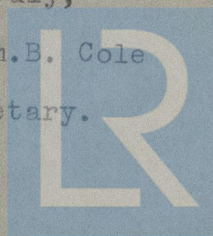
