I am enclosing herewith four Tensile Test Certificates for 4 Anchors to be placed onboard the s.s. "VENDIA" Messrs. Howaldtwerke's No 642.

The drop tests for these Anchors were made at Düsseldorf, from where same were sent in error to Kiel without making the necessary tensile tests.

In view of the above vessel being ready for her trial trip on the 10th inst. the tensile tests were made by me at a testing machine installed at the works of Messrs. Deutsche Werke A.G., Kiel, which is not approved by this Society and I shall be glad if you will kindly approve this having done in this case.

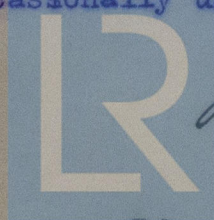
