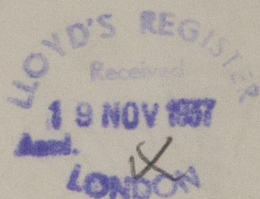

We also requested that the C.11 Report might be forwarded for our guidance, it being expected that the vessel would be ready for sea to-morrow.

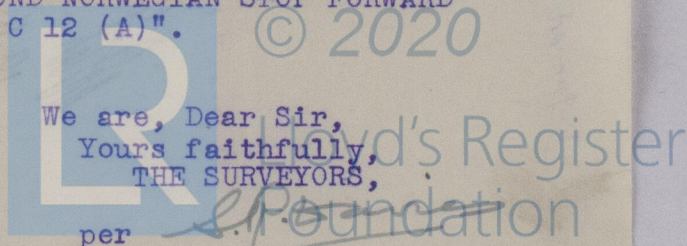
We have now to acknowledge receipt of your telegram with instructions as follows:-
