I enclose copy of a letter from Messrs George Brown & Co. regarding the distance from upper edge of Hatch Coaming to horizontal bulb angle stiffener on coaming side of No.1 Hatch, together with a sketch of the bulb angle stiffener as it is on vessel No. 201 and plan (in duplicate) showing construction of Hatch.

I shall be glad to know if the Builders request can be agreed to, and it is noted in this respect that the spacing of the hatch web slide angles is 5'-3".

The position of the work, at present, is that the coamings are erected with stiffeners in position shown and one side part riveted.
