**BELGIAN STEAMER SUNK BY U-BOAT**

**FIRED ON WITHOUT WARNING**  
FROM OUR OWN CORRESPONDENT  
PARIS, OCT. 5

The captain and crew of the Belgian steamer Suzon, which was sunk on Sunday night by a German submarine, have arrived at Brest.

They say that they were fired on without warning, the first shell being a miss and the second carrying away the wireless gear. They took to the boats, and some time later were picked up by a British destroyer, after which the destroyer attacked the submarine, with what result is not known.
