Referring to our letter of the 28th November last and the Danish Ministry's letter to us, dated the 4th December last (translation copy forwarded on the 7th Decbr.) regarding the Convention Freeboard for the Danish steamer "ENGLAND", we beg to enclose herewith a copy of the Freeboard Verification Form C 12(b) and at the same time to inform you that all requirements set forth by the Danish Authorities have been complied with, except that the air pipe on the poop has not been altered according to a dispensation given by the Danish Authorities later.

Also the Danish Ministry has been fully informed by us, and the Convention Freeboard Certificates have been issued.
